

The New York State Intelligence Center (NYSIC) serves as a central repository for numerous intelligence databases currently being used by the New York State Police and other local law enforcement agencies across the State. The NYSIC is a twenty-four hour, seven-day a week operation which will entail working all shifts with varying pass days, including HOLIDAYS AND WEEKENDS. The goals of this facility are to provide for "one stop shopping" for criminal intelligence data that is currently stored in a multitude of automated files, improve and strengthen the NYSIC's intelligence program, and protect the state against future terrorist attacks.

Special consideration will be given to those candidates who possess a demonstrated skill with a Geographic Information System (GIS) mapping software and its applications that capture, store, analyze, manage and present data that is linked to locations.
